



Eligibility Requirements


To be eligible to vote in the District of Columbia you must be:

- · A U.S. citizen
- · A D.C. resident
- . At least 18 years old on or before the election
- Not in jail for a felony conviction
- · Not been adjudged mentally incompetent by a court of law
- . Not claiming the right to vote anywhere outside D.C.
- ▶ ID Needed for Voter Registration




