Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to vote in the District of Columbia you must be:

- A U.S. citizen
- A D.C. resident
- At least 18 years old on or before the election
- Not in jail for a felony conviction
- Not been adjudged mentally incompetent by a court of law
- Not claiming the right to vote anywhere outside D.C.

Mayor of the District of Columbia

The Mayor of the District of Columbia is the chief executive officer of the District in whom the District's executive power is vested. To hold the office of Mayor of the District of Columbia, an individual must meet the following qualifications (D.C. Official Code § 1-204.21):

- Be a qualified elector in the District
- Not be engaged in any other employment and hold no other public office or position for which he is compensated in an amount in excess of his actual expenses
- Have resided and been domiciled in the District of Columbia for one year preceding the general or special election
- Have not been convicted of a felony while holding the office of Mayor

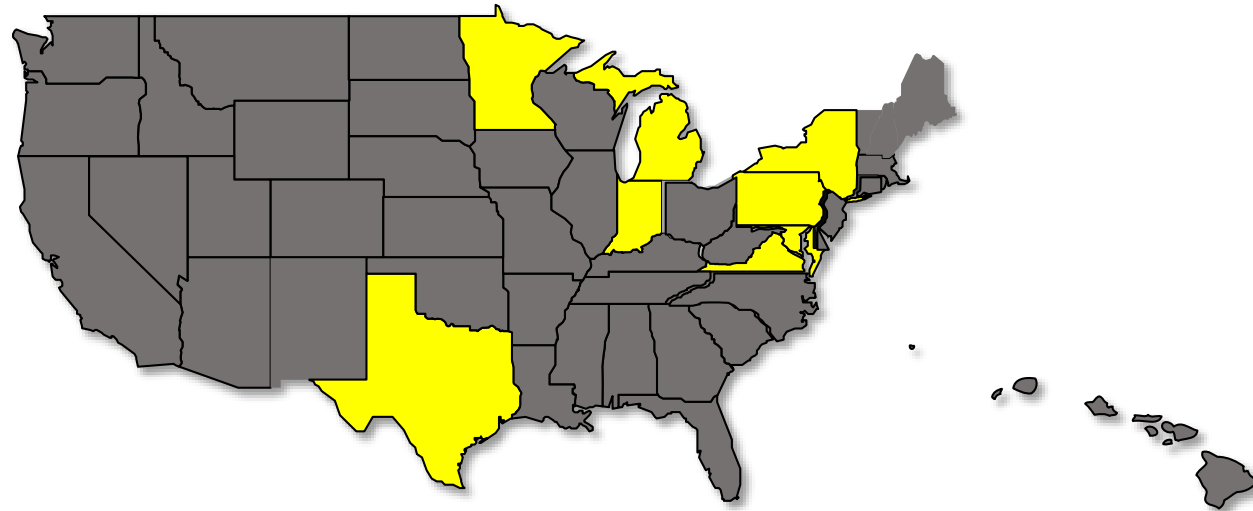

- Average cost per session: 31 cents



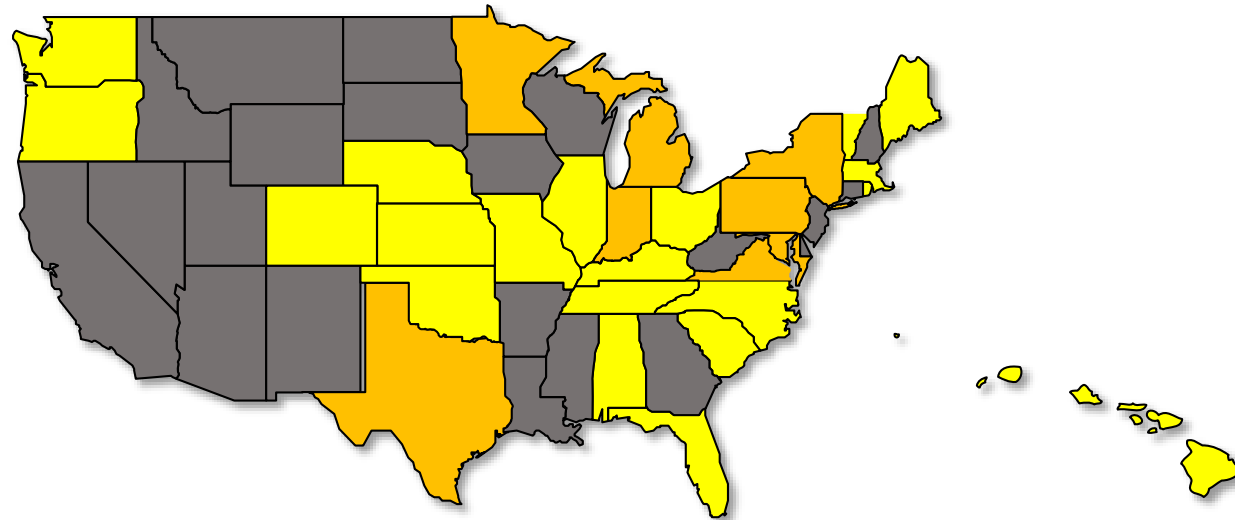
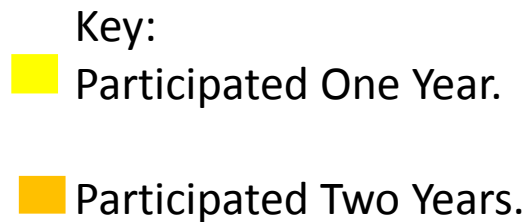

2012:

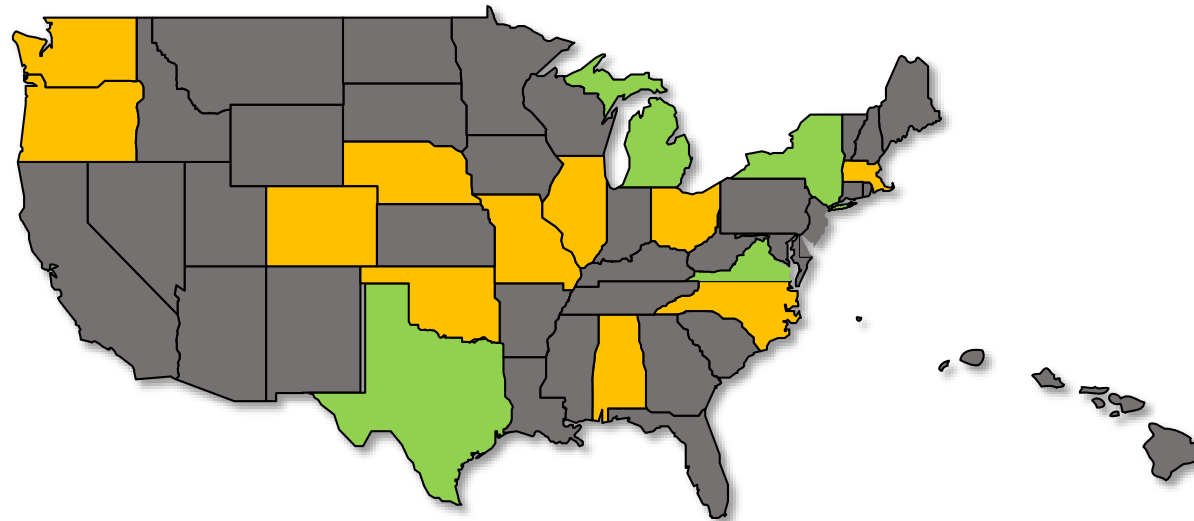
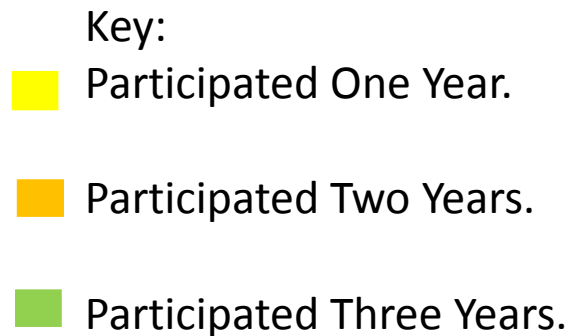
- 210 Leagues from 30 states created guides

- Average cost per session: 35 cents







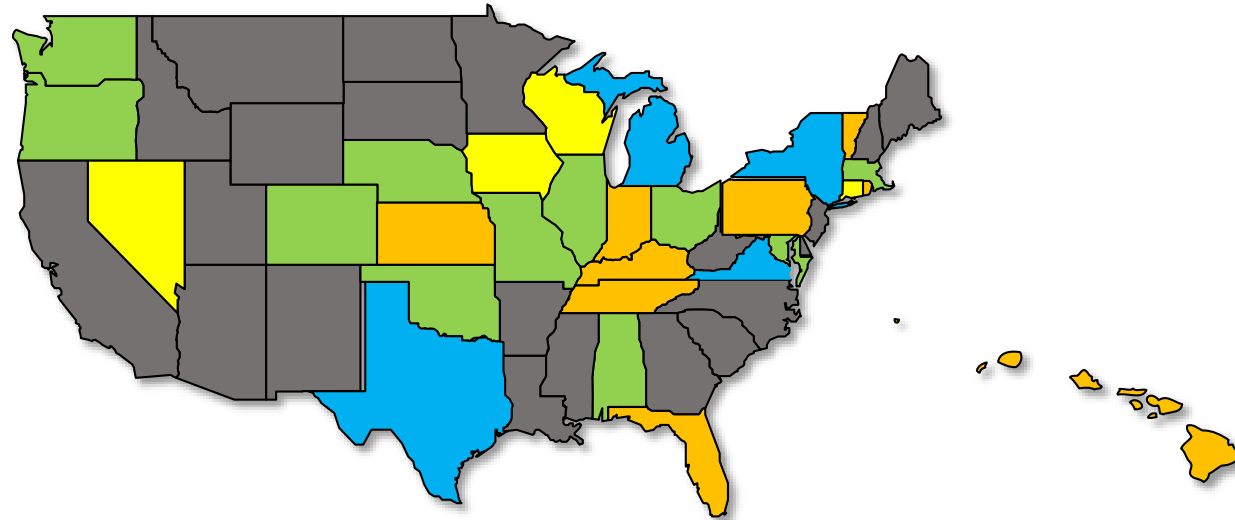
Online Voter Guide Growth

-  Participated Four Years.



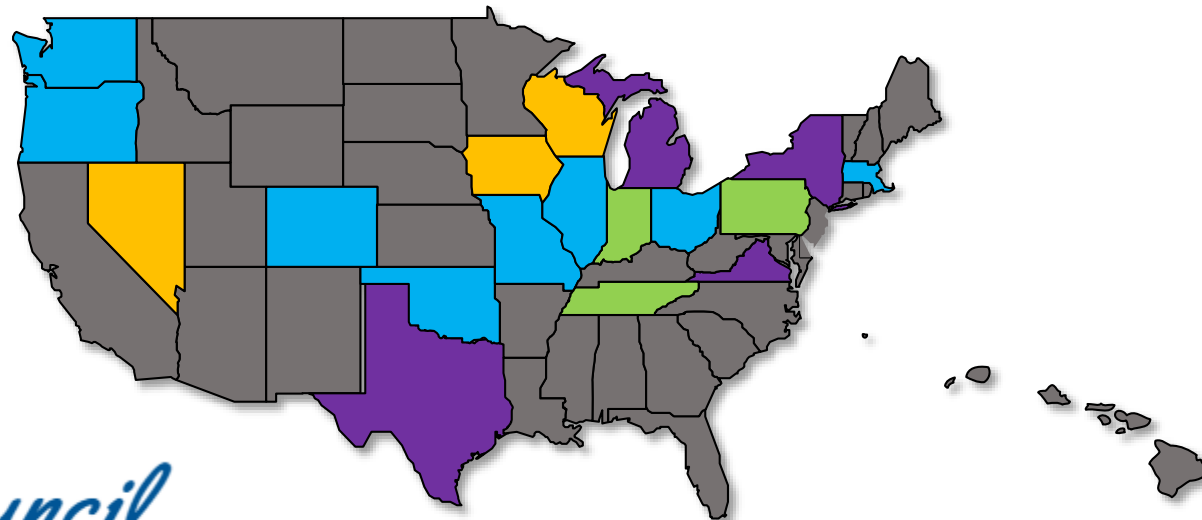
Online Voter Guide Growth
