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The above is from our DEI policy. Look at the characteristics that we use to define diversity and write or even think how you would describe yourself using at least 5 of them. For example you could say "My gender is female, my race is white, my ethnicity is Western and Eastern European, my marital status is single, and my educational level is college graduate".

Think about the different groups in your life: your neighbors, your coworkers, your League members, your friends, etc. How many of them would answer the same as you for some or all of those? How many would answer different? How does the percentages that are the same as you and different make you feel and what would you like to change?
