

Breakout: PTR

Supplies Needed:

- Three pieces of flip chart paper on the wall each with a different header: Preferences, Traditions, Requirements
- Post-its on the table
- Pens

Ask for someone to be the group reporter and review the instructions

Instructions

- Give the group 5-6 minutes to write down on post-its what they think of when they hear “the League way”
- Have everyone get up and place their post-its on the appropriate flip chart paper – is this a preference, tradition or requirement?
- Walk around and read what people have said
- Come back together as a group and discuss:
 - Is there anything that surprised you? Things you saw in one place that you didn’t agree with?
 - Are there things that are in multiple places? Meaning that within the group there is clear different opinions
 - Are there ways in which you think different understandings of “the League way” might be problematic/impede the ability of the League to be effective?
 - Examples of when you have seen this happen

Additional Considerations

- What if something I write can go more than one place? That’s fine – just write the same thing on more than one post-it.
- What is something I write doesn’t fit anywhere? Still write it down and then ask the group facilitator to put up another piece of paper and put it on that.
