
A National Redistricting Campaign for All Levels of League

- 1. Powerful collaboration between national, state, and local Leagues aimed at building power in communities across the country;
- 2. Coins a signature campaign that can be recognized for decades to come;
- 3. Focuses our redistricting work with a reform plan that allows an entry point for all levels of League;
- 4. Takes advantage of an opportunity to build capacity strategically in the field around a single topic and deepen the relationships between state Leagues and national office.
