



Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Task Force

#### Focus for 2021

In addition to United We Sit Campaign, we are focusing on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion locally.

The Colorado League made DEI a priority and with the change in leadership in Washington, we formed a LWVGV DEI Task Force in January .

Our program for February was Chloe Nicole Bowman, creator of Melanin Mountain Project, a local affiliate of Black Lives Matter.

In an effort to improve our DEI knowledge and practice, researching and attending AAUW & LWVCO webinars and other events.

- Attended 2-day local conference with Dr. Nita Mosby Tyler, founder of The Equity Project
- Met with Western Colorado University Diversity Club
- Added diversity topic books to our LWVGV library
- Black Women's Path to the Vote Six Minutes for Suffrage research
- DEI Task Force contributes frequently to meetings and website
- Applicant for Equity Grant from the Community Foundation of the Gunnison Valley
- LWVGV is in touch with Gunnison Valley Against Racism and other local groups on social media

#### Starting the 2<sup>nd</sup> Century of Suffrage Better Together –

Since the late 1960's women of all races in the US have the right to vote. This was not the case in August 1920. Now as we begin the 2<sup>nd</sup> 100 years of LWV, we continue to honor the women and men of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century who helped make this happen.

Members of the League of Women Voters of the Gunnison Valley have made suffrage history a priority over the past couple years! All this was achieved on top of election education, legislative action a new website and other work.

- Began with an informal book group reading and discussing Jailed for Freedom by Doris Stevens.
- Anniversary Tea for 100 on March 1, 2020 just before the Covid19 pandemic hit.
- Researched and executed an Anniversary Suffrage Quilt.
- LWVGV Suffrage Proclamations made by City of Gunnison and Gunnison County Board of Commissioners.
- Six Minutes of Suffrage and authoring our own books.
- Even Suffrage Recipe as part of the winter holiday plans.

# Suffrage Anniversary - Other LWVGV Projects











We will all remember 2020 for different reasons and for the same reason.

Other work accomplished by LWVGV in 2020 and 2021.

- Work continues despite Covid Meetings by Zoom, prepared pro/con ballot issues statement, voter registration duties, new website, rewrote our by-laws.

- **Communications Team** Spanning nine weeks with 22 articles in the two newspapers.
- Voter Services Team- Partnered with WCU candidates form several events, The Presidents play.

- **Suffrage Quilt** Created in isolation to honor Suffragists, potential fund raiser.
- Christmas Fundraiser Center for Mental Health






#### Suffrage Quilt Project


