
# What is the For the People Act?

The For the People Act (HR1, S1) is a sweeping democracy reform bill that was first introduced in 2019.


It is a comprehensive piece of legislation which is the most expansive democracy reform agenda we have seen since the Voting Rights Act was passed more than 50 years ago.

It will reinstall faith in our democracy by making elections fairer and putting power back into the hands of the American people.

### Modernizing Voter Registration and Participation

#### **Voting Rights Reforms**

Having voting rights protections and reforms in place would revolutionize our elections and make them more accessible, yield increased turnout, and ultimately elevate the voice of all Americans.

- Automatic Voter Registration (AVR)
- Vote by Mail
- Online Voter Registration
- Same Day Registration (SDR)
- Returning Citizens Voting Rights
- Reform Voter Purges

For the People Act: Redistricting

### Redistricting Reform

Requires states to use independent redistricting commissions for Congressional districts

Ends prison-based gerrymandering by counting incarcerated individuals at their last residence Creates **transparency**requirements for the
redistricting commission's
work and meetings and
provides mechanisms for
public input

Creates **clear mapping criteria** 


Create a ban on favoring or disfavoring political parties when drawing lines



- 1: Nonpartisan Legislative staff (IA)
- · 9: Advisory, Back up or **Politician Commissions** (AK, HI, OH, ME, PA, NJ, NY, RI, UT)
- 1: Strict Constitutional standards only (FL)

### How will For the People Act matter?

In over 30 states, it will create new gold standard for redistricting





### What if my state already has a commission?

- Does not affect existing commissions if comply with core pieces of HR1, including:
  - publicly available application process;
  - disqualifications for government service;
  - screenings for conflicts of interest;
  - multi-partisan composition;
  - a ban on drawing maps to favor a political party but requires minimizing division of communities of interest;
  - public input;
  - and broad-based support for the plan.



### Where and when do these apply?



Depending on timing of the bill's passage it may apply for 2022 mid terms in some states



Redistricting Criteria and Commissions will not be applicable until 2030


Constitutional Girding: Protects the legislation's provisions against future constitutional questions or challenges


### How the For The People Act Addresses State Voter Suppression Legislation



### How the For The People Act Addresses State Anti Voter Legislation

#### Promoting Voter Access:

- Expands early voting availability
- Reduces long lines
- Creates automatic voter registration and same-day registration
- Limits how states can purge voter rolls
- Reforms campaign finance law
- · Ends partisan gerrymandering





For the People Act vs. John Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act

Both pieces of legislation are essential in ridding our democracy of systemic racism and exclusion and building a new democracy

Lawmakers pitting these bills against each other are creating a false choice because they do not do the same thing!



## For the People Act

Reimagines American democracy into a system that works for the people.

Protects the freedom to vote, ends partisan gerrymandering, gets big money out of politics, and strengthens government ethics and accountability.

Creates national standards for voting

Would override many of the anti voters bills moving through state legislatures

Restore the VRA and ensure that every voter—regardless of where they live, what they look like, or what language the speak—has equal access to the ballot box and is protected from unfair laws and practices that make it more difficult to vote.

Restore the Preclearance process and update the Formula

Ensure Transparency and Notification to voters


Prevent FUTURE discriminatory laws


